

## EDUG 340 Working Group

### EPC Meeting 132, Library of Congress, November 16-17, 2009 Meeting DDC editors, November 18, 2009

On November 18 EDUG WG 340 chair, Yvonne Jahns, met with DDC editors Joan Mitchell, Julianne Beall, Giles Martin, Rebecca Green, Michael Panzer.

First we recapitulated the EPC meeting 132 and the discussion on 340 matters at November 16. EDUG had sent discussion papers on European Union law, theory of sources of law, juristic acts, criminal courts, criminal procedure and legal professions which were discussed as EPC exhibits 132-16.1-16.3.2a.

Federica Paradisi, WG member, sent some further comments on November 17 via e-mail. Her comments were integrated in the discussion, thus the future outline of EU law treatment at 341.2422 and within the 342-349 schedules could be clarified.

Joan Mitchell asked for the most important issue from the EDUG viewpoint which should be found in DDC23 and we agreed on EU law and the 341.2422 expansions.

After that we talked about the following matters - EDUG or German needs:

| 343.07869 building law                                | This built number is only for public building law, regulations, permits etc. There is need for an adequate number for private building law in 346, classifying building contracts, neighbour law etc. 346.024 and 346.036 have to be considered.   |
| Other civil law contracts have to be checked by EDUG. |  |
| 342.00269 constitutional courts                       | This is the right number for constitutional courts. This built number could be integrated in DDC23 because of its importance and also to clarify the differences between 347.7326 and here by a note.  |
